This position is responsible for the administrative, supervisory and technical work regarding the Kansas City, Missouri Fire Department information technology systems and employees.

Duties and Responsibilities

• Evaluates, trains, and directs IT employees within the KCFD department.

- Supervises and directs workflow and establish IT processes and procedures.
- Documents tasks for large scale IT projects within the KCFD.
- Works with and direct members of the department, across multiple divisions to implement or change IT work practices and procedures.
- Analyzes, designs, and recommends IT solutions across multiple divisions of the department to enhance our ability to achieve our mission.
- Assist with the development and execution of long term goals for the division that aligns with the
 objectives of the department.
- Works with and coordinates large projects with General Services and other departments within the City
- Assists with the construction and evaluation of Request for Proposals for departmental systems.
- Works with current and potential vendors to explore, implement, design, and or modify equipment or software specific the operations of the department.
- Manages, coordinates, and recommends equipment replacement schedule for the department.
- Develops/designs and implements technology solutions specific to the department.
