Summary

This is responsible work in receiving and stocking department supplies and equipment and preparing departmental equipment use in general operations.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Receive all supplies and record such on appropriate documents.
- Decontaminate clean, detail and stock ambulances, vehicles and trailers
- Disperse and receive equipment that is assigned to companies or other personnel and document on the unit check in and checkout form
- Check and add vehicle fluids as assigned
- Required to respond to scenes with additional equipment when directed by the department.
- Able to retrieve equipment from stations, hospitals and from other locations and prepare it for service
- Able to perform equipment preventative maintenance as specified by the department
- Report any medical equipment malfunction through the chain of command
- Perform related duties as required.

Technical Skills

Considerable knowledge of:

The department's electronic communication systems.

Ability to:

- Access all areas within the ambulance and must be able to get in and out of the ambulance which is equal to 19" step.
- Lift equipment into the storage space of an ambulance, storage shelf or other location
- Utilize a ladder (12" rungs) to access supplies and equipment
- Push and pull (80 lb.) pallet jack.
- Manipulate 140 lb. oxygen tank into position.
