Summary

This is an advanced level professional staff position within the IT department.

Work involves responsibility for leading and performing work of a unit engaged in varied computer operations and architecture projects. Employees of this class may assist lower level IT associates with more complex technical projects and problems. Under limited supervision, the IT Analyst provides leadership and coordination of project teams engaged in small size projects. Performs related activities and makes recommendations in areas that require a high level of technical competency.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Direct medium projects in a competent fashion. Provides instruction to assigned team to effectively accomplish assigned projects. Provides task direction as necessary. Follows appropriate processes and procedures for assigned projects.
- Makes significant contributions to the success of projects by applying demonstrated knowledge. Performs technical review of work performed by project team.
- Anticipates hardware and software needs and make recommendations related to the acquisition of such.
- Installs and maintains hardware and software in accordance with prescribed procedures.
- Prepares system documentation within established standards.
- Writes or revises complex program documentation, operations documentation and user guides in accordance with standards.
- Prepares highly complex technical and quality control testing activities in accordance with prescribed procedures. Prepares test data and analyzes program or application performance during testing.
- Compares testing results with provided documentation to identify and resolve any discrepancies.
- Participates in selecting and implementing operation systems and architecture improvements.
- Analyzes problems, determines cause and initiates corrective action in areas that require an expert level of technical competency.
- Leads project teams in the implementation of design/analysis and programming/coding
- Codes or scripts complex modules of programs as needed.
- Performs a variety of complex programming tasks, such as designing, documenting, and developing program logic.
- Prepares instructional materials and training curriculum for operation and user training.
- Utilizes interpersonal and communication skills to train, instruct and educate groups and individuals in a team environment.
- Provides technical expertise to other members on the team for their technical development.
- Recommends process or procedure changes. Participates in process and quality improvement.
- Follows through on commitments made to customers. Assures that customer requirements are met.
- Works effectively with peers, team members, and other departments.
- Performs related work as required.

- Design, configuration, installation, deployment, and implementation of applications, infrastructure, networks (voice, data, video), pc, and servers (operating systems, monitoring software, system software).
- Coding, programming, development, and support of applications, client server, database, mainframe, and WEB.
