Summary

This is specialized work involving the teaching of groups learning a particular recreational

activity.

Work involves responsibility for fulfilling specific duties as directed by supervisory personnel.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist in organizing and conducting classes in recreational activities.
- Assists in the planning, leading and implementing of programs in a specific activity to meet the needs of a particular age group.
- Assists in conducting special tournaments and contests.
- Work as a team member with other recreational personnel.
- Encourages widespread participation in an activity and ensures the maximum benefit to all participating individuals.
- Forward public complaints and suggestions for the particular program or facility to appropriate facility manager.
- Performs related duties as required.

Technical Skills

Considerable knowledge of:

The rules, equipment, and techniques of a given recreational activity.

Ability to:

Perform at a level of proficiency in the particular activity for which recruited.

Demonstrate the required techniques of a given specialty in such a way that others will be able to benefit from the instruction.

Communicate freely and effectively at all age levels.

High school graduation and six (6) months experience in recreational activity.

- May be required to possess a valid State –issued driver's license in accordance with the City of KCMO policies.
- Will be required to pass a preemployment drug screen and background check as prescribed by the City.
